Computer science majors may apply for admission to a special program that leads to a Bachelor of Science degree at the end of the fourth year and a Master of Science degree at the end of the fifth year. Students must satisfy the respective requirements of both degrees, but the main advantage of the program is that six credits may be simultaneously applied to both the undergraduate and graduate requirements.

Students usually apply to the program in their junior year. Applications are reviewed, and must be approved, by the Computer Science Graduate Admissions Committee. The application process is competitive. To be considered applicants must have a GPA of 3.25 or higher, both overall and in major courses, and completed at least three upper-division computer science courses at Stony Brook. In the past, successful applicants had a GPA of 3.40 or higher in computer science courses. Applications must also include (i) a statement of purpose, (ii) a one or two-page resume, and (iii) two or three recommendation letters, at least one from a computer science faculty member.
